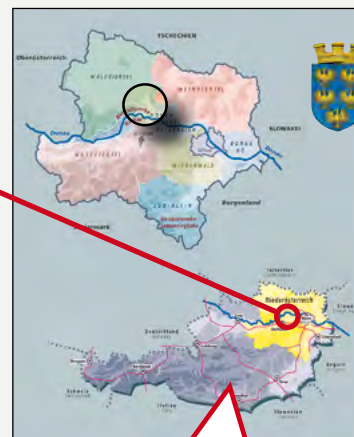




Rally Trophy Final

- The 3 highest scoring ERT drivers and co-drivers from each area
- The 3 highest scoring ERT 2 drivers and co-drivers from each area
- The 3 highest scoring ERT 3 drivers and co-drivers from each area
- The 3 highest scoring ERT Junior drivers from each area.

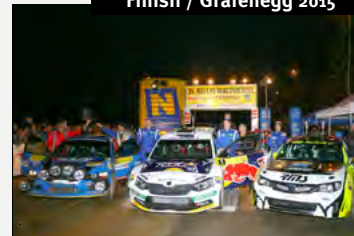

The international Rally Waldviertel is one of the best rated events of the **FIA European Rally Trophy** also includes:

The event take place from 17th till 19th of November 2016

Grafenegg/Krems, Niederösterreich.

The international Rally Waldviertel is characterized as a gravel event with a mixed segments of tarmac. Special Stages over 160km and an overall length of 430 km. The special stages are situated in the southern parts WALDVIERTEL / NIEDERÖSTERREICH in the districts St.Pölten, Krems, Horn, Hollabrunn.

The 1st day will count 4 stages in St.Pölten. The Major City of Niederösterreich with Start and live television coverage on the super special stage. The 2nd day consists 4 different stages with a length between 6,4 and 22,5 kilometres. Each stage, driven two times. At least 60% gravel on both days.

The rally will be run in compliance with the 2016 FIA Rally Sporting Regulations and the National Sporting Regulations of the OSK and includes the national final of the Austrian championships & rally cups.

Supplementary regulations will be published in English and German.

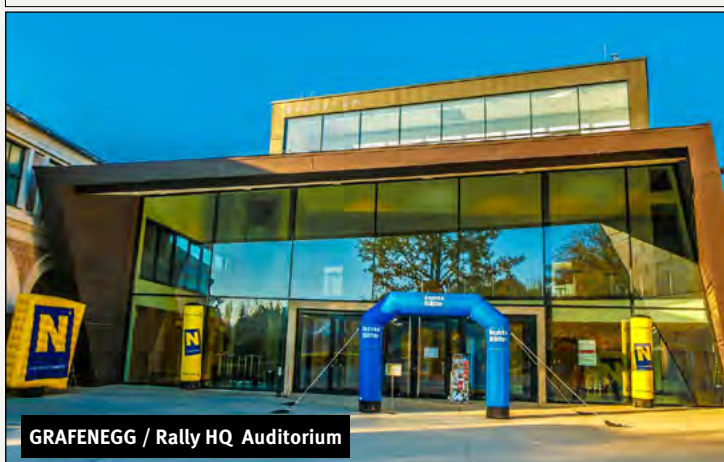
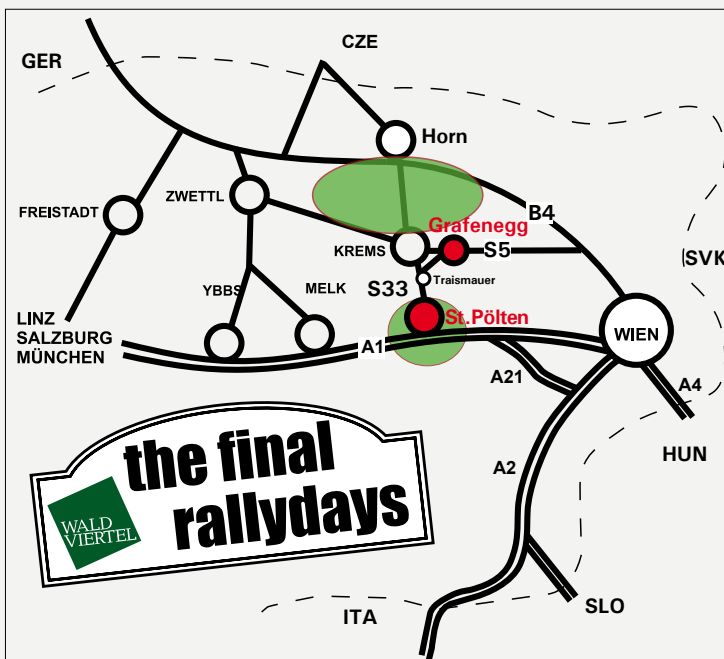
