4. Service Park

4.1 Location

There will be one Service Park during the rally, located in GRAFENEGG „parking area“ and one small service parc in the VAZ Area St. Pölten fo 15 minutes Service “A”. Each team/competitor will be allocated a designated space according to supplementary regulations. After the close of entries, each competitors location will be drawn in the service park layout, and will be published on the official web site.

4.2 Service & auxiliary vehicles

Only service vehicles (identified with Service plates issued by the organiser) are allowed to enter and exit the main Service Park. Service cars are only allowed to set-up at times according to Art. 4.4. For access to the Auxiliary parking area the vehicles must carry an Auxiliary plate. Additional Auxiliary plates may be ordered by contacting secretariat.

4.3 Restrictions on the ground

It is forbidden under any circumstances to drill holes in the tarmac or the concrete ground at the Service Park. Teams and competitors are asked to bring weights for tents and others that need to be fastened. On Friday 6th Nov., Service Park Coordinator will inspect the Service Park area to check if there is any damage on the ground. In case of a damage caused by the competitors, relevant cost will be charged.

4.4 Access times for set-up

The access to service park will be opened from Thursday, 17.11.2016 at 15:00 hrs, for designated service vehicles only. Private security will be provided upon request and payment. Please also note that specific service park facilities such as electricity, internet-connection etc could be provided. Management staff and officials, who are in charge for Service Park, will be on duty from Thursday, 17.11.2016 10:00 hrs onwards.

12.1 Pre-Start Holding Park

Before the Start, a pre-start holding park in the VAZ St.Pölten will be organised, where the cars must be present latest at 12:30 hrs.

12.2 Start Details

From 13:00 hrs onwards, the crews will take start according to Start List.

At start time of the crew, the crew will drive onto the start ramp where they will be presented to spectators and media members.



13. FINISH PROCEDURE

Please find the layout of finish ceremony in the Appendices Rally Guide II

Official Finish of the rally will be at TC 12D in GRAFENEGG SERVICE AREA competitors have to follow officials' instructions and pass the finish ramp - Third Overall, Second Overall, Winner and following cars according to their due time at TC12C.

Finish ramp order and procedure chronology:

Third Overall car is driven onto the ramp. Stops on the center of ramp. Stops the engine. Crew get out of the car, receives their winning-wreaths and should be positioned Wave for photographers (1 min). Drive off ramp in direction in front of the podium and leave the car to the mechanics at the right hand side. Crew remains there and a mechanic shall drive the car into the ,final parc ferme.

Second Overall and winner: Exactly the same procedure as Third Overall Drivers announced procede to their places on the podium in order third, second, winner. National anthems of winning driver and winning manufacturer will be played.

Then presenters or honorary persons hand over the trophies for each crew member shake their hands and move back out of photographers' view.

After the trophies ceremony, all three crews will receive their pre-cracked bottles of champagne and celebrate their victory for photographers with champagne .

All other crews cross the ramp in the order, determined according to their arrival time in TC and directly drive to the ,parc ferme'.

The Final Price giving of the Event and for the FIA European Rally Trophy will be held at place Rally HQ Center Auditorium Grafenegg „REITSCHULE“ on date Saturday 19th of November time 21:15

From TC 12C (Finish Holding Zone), finish ceremonies- and drive to Final Parc Fermé.

Finish ramp order and procedure chronology : after the finish podium, where the time cards of competitors will be collected. The master of ceremony is responsible for following procedure : beside the car with opened doors.

Please do not stand anywhere on the stage that might cause danger to yourself, or the competitors or the concentration of the competitors. Please ensure that your media pass and numbered media tabbard is clearly visible during the rally, including entrance to the Media Center.

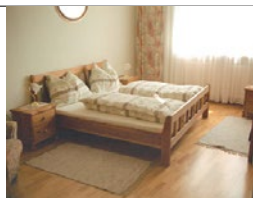

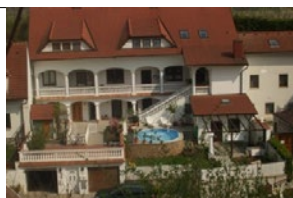

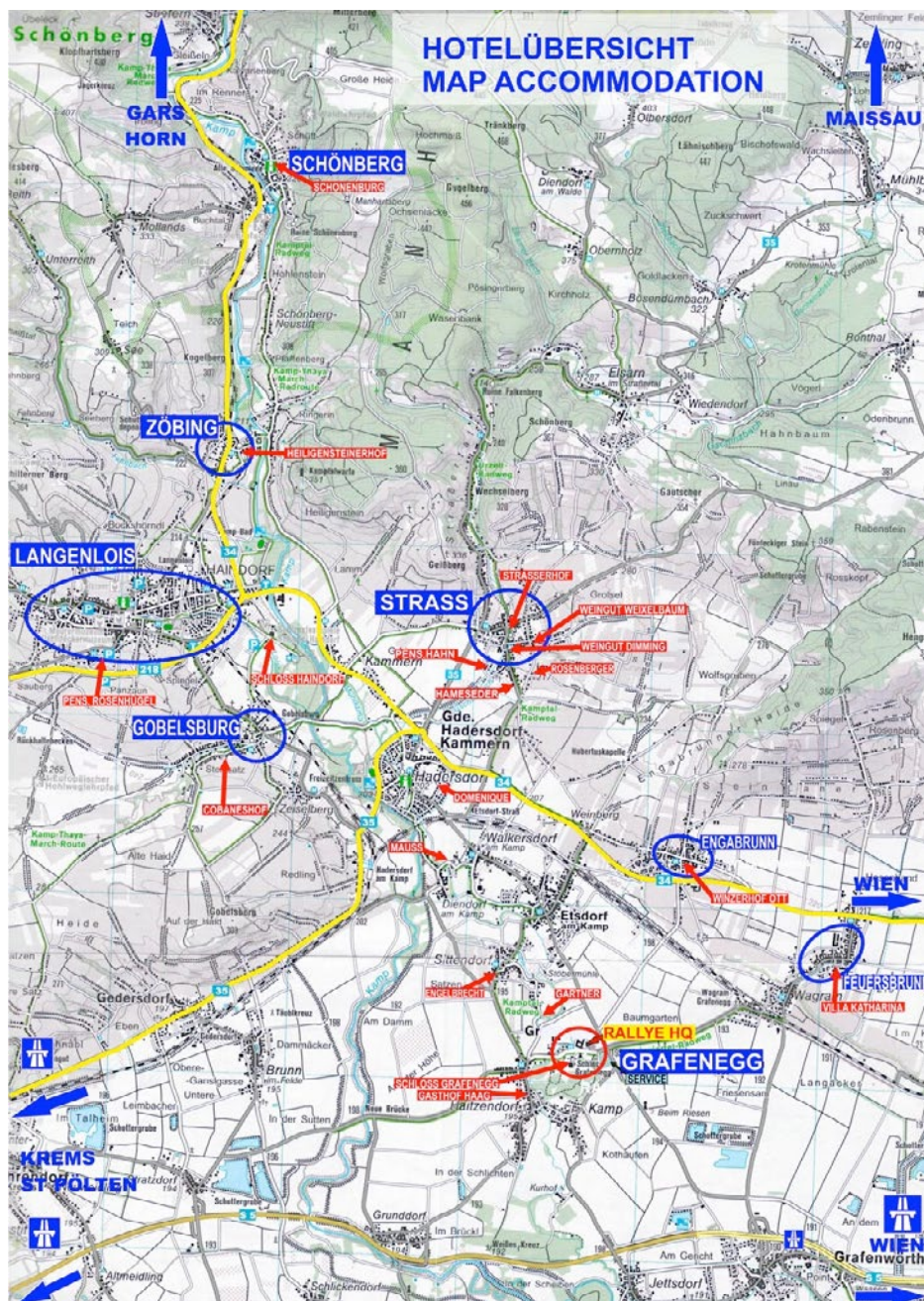
